## New Energy Efficient Front Load Washers Installed

**The Catholic University of America has gone GREEN!** Over the summer, new energy efficient front load washers were installed on campus. It is important for you to remember a few things when using the new machines:

◆ **Since these washers use a lot less water, you will need to use a lot less soap!** It is highly recommended that you only use **liquid HE-type detergent**. Look for this symbol → → → → → →  
All the major manufacturers offer this type of detergent for usually the same price as their other types. It is specifically formulated to be low-sudsing. Follow directions on the back of the bottle. Do not use powdered detergent.



- ◆ Detergent and liquid fabric softener go into the dispenser drawer, not on your clothing. Do not use a Downy Ball in these washers- it will not work properly.
- ◆ Cycle time on the display is approximate. Final spin may take longer than the time display shows.
- ◆ The door will lock approximately 30 seconds after the cycle starts and will not unlock until about 30 seconds after the cycle completes.
- ◆ 1 wash = 1 dry!
- ◆ These washers will wash a twin-sized comforter (by itself)!
- ◆ **NO COINS NEEDED!** "Free" laundry is an added benefit of living on campus!

## Other Laundry Tips



- ◆ Be sure to read and follow the directions on your clothing labels.
- ◆ Empty all pockets! Gum, chapstick, pens and even tissue can damage your clothing if it melts/explodes or disintegrates in the dryer.
- ◆ Pre-treat all stains. There are great products on the market to help you get rid of stains. Drying will set stains so you want to get to them quickly.
- ◆ Sort clothes into at least lights and darks.
- ◆ Empty the dryer lint filter every time.
- ◆ Please do not wash/dry shoes in these machines.
